

# Hearing



## You Will Need For Each Child

☛ Note: Boys will make a boy and girls will make a girl.					
Background	1 white rectangle	9"	x	12"	
Shirt	1 royal blue rectangle	4"	x	8"	
Texts					
Head	1 skin tone square	5½"	x	5½"	
Ears	1 skin tone rectangle	1½"	x	4"	
Hair ★					
Top	1 rectangle	2"	x	5½"	
Sides (girls)	1 rectangle	1½"	x	3"	
Earphones	1 black rectangle	¾"	x	3½"	
Scissors, glue, black, brown crayons, pencil					

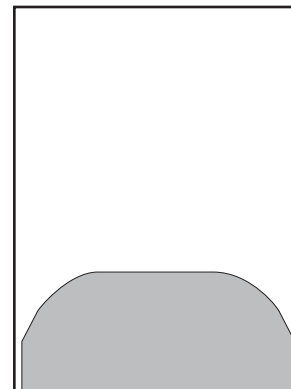
★ I did not give a color for the hair.  
Each child will pick his/her hair color piece(s).

### 1.) Background: (white rectangle)



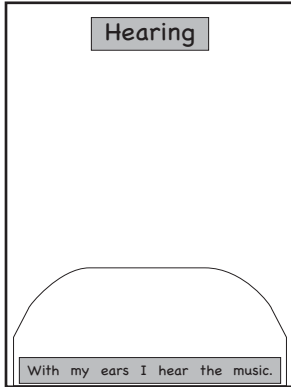
- Place the white rectangle in a vertical position on the table

### 2.) Shirt: (royal blue rectangle)



- Hold the rectangle in a horizontal position; cut off the top two corners and round  
(See TLC Cuts for "hill cut" instructions)
- Glue the shirt in a horizontal position at the bottom of the white rectangle

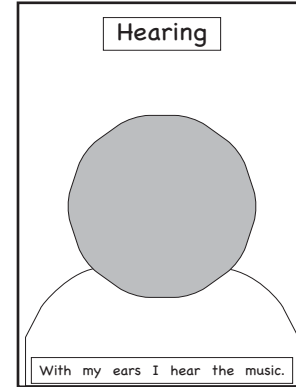
### 3.) Texts:



- Glue the texts as shown

### 4.) Head:

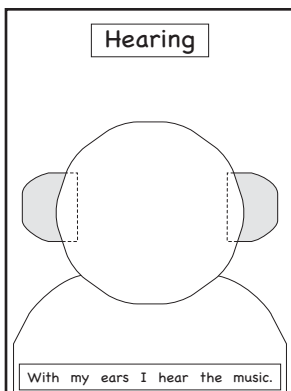
(skin tone square)



- Cut the square into a circle  
(See TLC Cuts for "circle cut" instructions)
- Glue the head to the white rectangle; overlap the shirt as shown

### 5.) Ears:

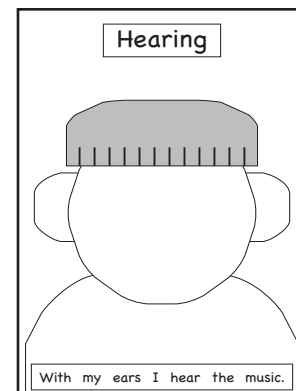
(skin tone rectangle)



- Fold the rectangle in half so you can cut two ears at a time
- Hold the folded rectangle in a horizontal position; cut off the top two corners and round; if the pieces are connected cut apart on the fold line
- Lift the head and glue the ears as shown

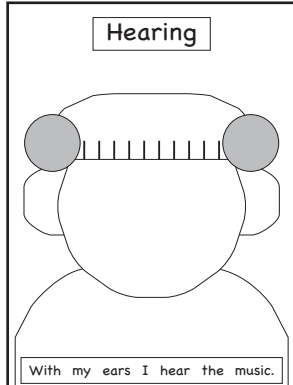
### 6.) Hair Top:

(longer hair color rectangle)



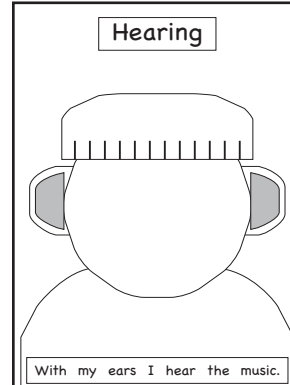
- Hold the rectangle in a horizontal position; cut off the top two corners and round
- Fringe the opposite side  
(see TLC Cuts for "fringe cut" instructions)
- Glue the hair to the head as shown

## 7.) Hair Sides/Girls: (smaller hair color rectangle)



- Fold the rectangle in half so you can cut two hair pieces at a time
- Cut a circle; if the pieces are connected cut apart on the fold line
- Glue the hair pieces as shown

## 8.) Earphones: (black rectangle)



- Fold the black rectangle in half
- Hold the rectangle in a horizontal position; cut off the top two corners and round; if the pieces are connected cut apart on the fold line
- Glue the earphones on the ears as shown

## 9.) Details/Name: (black, brown crayons, pencil)



- Use the black crayon to draw the wire connecting the earphones and music notes
- Use the brown crayon to draw two closed eyes, eye lashes, nose, sound marks and mouth
- Turn your paper over and write your name at the bottom

Optional: The teacher may want to embellish the child by giving him/her red cheeks (Rub red chalk on a cotton ball and apply to the cheek area)
